Eucomis – white with pink tinge Large bulbs – have flowered D \$6.00
Height to 45 cms+. Sun and good drainage. Autumn flowering. Potted.

Eucomis – white with pink tinge Medium sized bulbs D 3 for \$12.00
Height to 45 cms+. Sun and good drainage. Impressive in autumn. Potted.

Galanthus nivalis ‘Sam Arnott’ Summer/autumn dormant 3 for \$15.00
(Snowdrops). Supposed to be the easiest and one of the nicest to grow with very large flower.
Delightful in july/august for the first of the spring bulbs. Very good drainage, sun to part shade.

Haemanthus Albiflos Few \$12.00
White. 2 to 3 leaves in 2022. Lovely smooth and shiny leaves, long flowering season and red berries.
Dappled shade or in pots. To 25 cms when in flower. Plant with the upper half of the bulb above the
soil level. The compact flower heads are up to 5cm wide, consisting of numerous erect, narrow white
flowers. The erect stamens protrude conspicuously beyond the tips of the flowers and the anthers turn
yellow or orange when ripe. Protect from hard frost – not fully hardy.

To 60 cms. (Summer Snowflake). Nodding bell-shaped, white, green-tipped flowers in spring.
Suitable for naturalising, rock gardens, under shrubs and trees, woodland gardens and in flower beds.

(Summer Hyacinth). Tall with dark green strap-like foliage. Pretty bell-shaped white flowers tinged
with green in summer. Stunning cut flower. Full sun. Loved by bees and butterflies

To 35 cms. Masses of large pink, trumpet shaped flowers from late spring.

Incarvillea delvayi 20 for \$4.00
To 35 cms. Masses of large, pure white trumpet shaped flowers from late spring. Cut back after flowering so this will rebloom. Bold, divided leaves. Sun. Moist, well-drained soil. Nice for pots.

Iris chrysographes 'Black Knight' 20 for \$5.00
60 to 80 cms. Deep violet purple flowers in summer.

Lathyrus latifolius 'White Pearl' 30 for \$4.00
Large white flowers in summer. Climber. Sun.

Ratibida pinnata 30 for \$4.00
1.2 metres. (Yellow Coneflower). Showy yellow flowers with droopy soft yellow rays. Cone-like green centres. Attracts insects. Drought tolerant. Excellent cut flower. Sun or part shade.

Sisyrinchium californicum 30 for \$4.00
(Yellow-Eyed Grass). To 20 cms. Star-shaped, dark-veined, bright yellow flowers in summer. Long flowering. Clump forming. Sun. Suit coastal areas. Tolerates a little shade. Becomes drought tolerant

To 1 metre. Erect spikes bear dense white flowers studded with purple and orange 'eyes' Sun or light shade. Cut spent spike and new ones will be produced. Rich green leaves form a nice rosette.

To 50 cms. Deep green foliage, soft yellow daisy-like flowers summer/autumn. Sun. Makes an ideal middle of border plant, cottage garden, rock garden, pots.

To 35 cms. Fragrant single blooms spring to autumn. Fringed petals of bright cranberry red with a contrasting rose-pink eye. Great for rockery or edging. Attractive to butterflies. Sun. 1.5 litre.

To 30 cms. Semi-double flowers, white and edged in wine red/purple red centres. Spicy fragrance.

- Dictamnus albus albiflorus (Burning Bush) D \$11.00
 Rare. Year two plants – may take 2 years to flower. Mature plants grow to about 90 cms. Highly fragrant, white, 5-petalled flowers with long, projecting stamens are borne in long, open racemes in early summer. They and the unripe fruit, produce an aromatic, volatile oil which may be ignited in hot weather. Specimen plant best planted where you can brush past it so the beautiful fragrance is released. Suits a perennial border. Grow in dry, well drained, moderately fertile soil in full sun.
- Dictamnus albus var. purpureus D \$10.00
 (Burning Bush). Year one plants. May take 3 years to flower. Mature plants are 80 to 90 cms. Highly fragrant, purple - mauve, 5-petalled flowers with darker veins and long, projecting stamens are borne in long, open racemes in early summer. Specimen plant in garden and best planted where you can brush past them so you can enjoy the fragrance released.
- Doronicum caucasicum (Leopard's Bane) D \$10.00
 To 45 cms. Large daisy like flowers in spring. Moist but well-drained soil. Sunny border, light shade or woodland garden. Large pots.
- Echinacea purpurea 'Happy Star' Trimmed D \$12.00
 75cm+ when in flower. Pure white petals are in a horizontal position around large orange-yellow cones. Long-lasting cut flower. Summer flowering.
- Echinacea purpurea 'Magnus' Trimmed D \$12.00
 (Purple Coneflower). To 1 metre. Beautiful rose pink ray petals with a coppery brown, spiky central cone. Large vibrant daisy-like flowers summer to autumn. Attracts butterflies and insects. Sun.

 To 1 metre. Large daisy-like flowers with magenta- pink petals surrounding an orange/brown central cone in mid-summer. Great for cutting. Attracts butterflies and birds. Sun. Adaptive to conditions.

 To 55 cms Bright rose-magenta petals surrounding a large orange button-shaped cone. Ideal for sunny borders, the flowers are great for cutting. Attractive to butterflies. Flower midsummer.

 Low growing, clump forming, ground cover for a sunny spot, rockery or over edging. Pretty orange coloured flowers – long flowering.
