Scilla hohenackeri 3 for \$10.00
To 20 cms. Loose racemes of star-shaped, light blue flowers bloom in spring. Sun/part shade.

Scilla ramburei 3 for \$10.00
To 20 cms. Numerous 1 cm lavender blue flowers each with a single bract crowded into a spike above narrow leaves in spring. Sun.

Scilla tubergiana \$8.00
Height to 15 cms. Showy, star-shaped, pale blue flowers August. Sun/light shade. Good drainage, suits woodland, wild or naturalised areas, rock gardens, edging, cottage gardens. Summer dormant.

Seeds

Clanthus puniceus (Kakabeak) 30 for \$4.00
Native shrub with striking clusters of red flowers. To 2 metres. Flowers spring to early summer.

Francoa sonchifolia 30 for \$4.00
(Bridal Wreath). Dark green leaves to 30 cms. Spikes to 70 cms with pale pink flowers with deeper pink veins. Sun/part shade. Good cut flower.

Perennials

Aconitum napellus COLLECT MID SPRING ONWARDS D \$8.00
(Monkshood). 1.5 metres. Hooded deep blue flowers on very erect spikes late summer/early autumn. Tall, impressive plant for back of border – staked. Easy to grow, part shade, moist soil.

Alyssum saxatilis citrinum \$9.00
Creamy lemon. Clump forming ground cover. Suitable for sunny rockery/borders/over edging.

Alyssum saxatilis ‘Dudley Nevill’ \$10.00
Soft yellowish-tan flowers. Sun and good drainage.

Alyssum saxatilis Yellow \$9.00
To 30 cms. Low growing with bright yellow flowers. Sun and good drainage. Suits rock gardens, rock walls or edging.

Amenopsis macrophylla D \$10.00
Choice woodland to 55 cms. Divided, ferny foliage. Slender, elegant spikes bear nodding, opalescent flowers. White with amethyst/violet. Humus-rich, semi-shaded, moist but well drained.

Anemone magellanica D \$10.00
To 40 cms. (Windflower). Creamy lemon bowl-shaped flowers spring/summer. Sun/part shade

Aquilegia Crystal Star – Red D \$9.00
To 60 cms. Long spurred red flowers. Sun, good drainage.

Armeria maritima \$8.00
(Sea Thrift). Globes of bright pink flowers and great for sunny rockery situation or border edging. Compact, low clump-forming ground cover. Large plants – 1.5 litre pots.

- Aruncus aesthusifolius* D \$9.00
To 30 cms. Dwarf variety. Fern-like leaves and astilbe like plumes of tiny, creamy white flowers late spring to summer. Sun/part shade. Moist soil.
- Astilbes may need collected or trimmed from end of October onwards.
- Astilbe 'Fuschia Spangles'* D \$9.00
Fat, fluffy spires of a brilliant pink. Early flowering. Semi-shade.
- Astilbe 'Montgomery'* D \$9.00
To 75 cms. Compact variety with dramatic scarlet-red plumes. Bronze-green, glossy foliage. Excellent cut flower. Moist but well-drained soil in part shade.
- Astrantia major Rubra.* D \$9.00
To 60 cms. Plum red. Unusual flowers that are a group of tightly packed florets that are backed by petal-like bracts. This makes the flowers look much like a star or a firework. Sun or part shade, moist.
- Campanula* D \$8.00
Unnamed, possibly an alpine. Small, upward-facing, star-shaped, lavender purple flowers spring to summer. Sun. Slow growing.
- Campanula Dickson's Gold* D \$9.00
To 15 cms. Striking bright gold, toothed leaves-colour is lime green if grown in part shade. Lavender blue star-shaped, upward facing flowers late spring to mid-summer. Compact for rockery or edging.
- Campanula glomerata 'Superba'* D \$8.00
To 30 cms. Upright purple bells in summer. 1 litre.
- Campanula latifolia* Few D \$9.00
60 cms. Spikes of large, white funnel-shaped bell flowers late spring to early summer. Sun or partial shade. 1 litre.
- Campanula 'Mist Maiden'* D \$10.00
Light green foliage and small white bells summer/early autumn. Sun. Rockery or front of border.
- Campanula persicifolia double white* D \$9.00
To 80 cms. Tall stems with double white flowers down stems. Sun/part shade. Clump forming ground cover.
- Campanula rotundifolia* D \$8.00
20 cms. (Bluebells of Scotland). Graceful, nodding, mauve-purple bells in early summer. Ideal for edging, containers and rock garden. Sun.
- Campanula 'Van Houtei' (Mystic Bells)* D \$9.00
60 cms. Pretty, clump forming ground cover for sunny area. Constant abundance of large mid blue flowers from late spring to autumn. A light trim encourages new flushes of flowers. 1 litre.
- Centaurea cheiranthifolia* D \$10.00
To 45 cms. Large white flowers with deep purple stamens from late spring. Blue-grey leaves. Sun or part shade.
- Centaurea Dealbata* D 9.00
To 60 cms. Dark pink flowers over divided foliage. Sun or part shade - tolerates drier conditions.

D = winter dormant

- Centaurea pulcherrima* D \$10.00
To 40 cms. Grey green feathered foliage with large rose-pink flowers. Sun.
- Centaurea ruthenica* D \$10.00
To 1.2 metres. Dark green, pointed ferny foliage with grey undersides. Flowers have fluffy thistle-style heads which are a pale yellow with very fine crinkled tissue buff-coloured bracts. Good for cutting. Sun and well drained soil.
- Coreopsis verticillata* D \$9.00
40 cms. Bushy rhizomatous perennial with numerous branched stems. Bears yellow daisy like flowerheads in loose corymbs in early summer. Sun or part shade, well-drained soil. 1.5 litre
- Coreopsis verticillata* 'Moonbeam' D \$9.00
50 cms. Deep green foliage, soft yellow daisy-like flowers summer/autumn. Sun. Makes an ideal middle of border plant, cottage garden, rock garden, pots.
- Corydalis flexuosa* D \$8.00
To 40 cms. Upright slender, long spurred, tubular blue flowers with whitish throats late spring to early summer. May be summer dormant, then autumn flowering. Rhizomatous ground cover for shade.
- Delphinium vestitum* D \$10.00
Rare. To 60 cms. Finely textured, blue-violet and deep black flowers. Hairy petals. Rounded leaves. Some shade best.
- Dianthus Cranberry Ice* \$9.00
To 35 cms. Fragrant single blooms spring to autumn. Fringed petals of bright cranberry red with a contrasting rose-pink eye. Great for rockery or edging. Attractive to butterflies. Sun.
- Dianthus Dad's Favourite* \$9.00
25 cms. Popular variety. Flowers are semi-double, white and edged in wine red with purple red centres. Spicy fragrance.
- Dicentra cucullaria* Pink Few D \$9.00
To 30 cms. Spring emerging fern-like leaves with arching stems carrying dusky-pink blooms. Woodland ground cover.
- Dicentra spectabilis* – Pink (Bleeding Heart) Few D \$15.00
Partial shade/woodland. Good drainage.
- Dictamnus albus* var. *purpureus* D \$8.00
(Burning Bush). Plants are 3 years old.. May take 1-2 years to flower. Mature plants are 80 to 90 cms. Highly fragrant, purply - mauve, 5-petalled flowers with darker veins and long, projecting stamens are borne in long, open racemes in early summer. Specimen plant in garden and best planted where you can brush past them so you can enjoy the fragrance released. 1 litre pots
- Disporopsis omeiensis* \$9.00
Resembles an evergreen Solomon's Seal with snakeskin patterns on the stem, pale greenish-yellow flowers. 1 litre.
- Disporum sessile* 'Variegatum' D \$9.00
The 25mm hanging creamy white bells are incidental to the beautiful green and white striped variegated leaves, stems to about 25 cms. An excellent groundcover under shrubs.

- Doronicum caucasicum* (Leopard's Bane) D \$8.00
To 45 cms. Large daisy like flowers in spring. Moist but well-drained soil. Sunny border, light shade or woodland garden.
- Echinacea purpurea* 'Magnus' D \$9.00
(Purple Coneflower). Beautiful rose pink ray petals with a coppery brown, spiky central cone. Petals are held horizontally. Large daisy-like flowers summer to autumn. Sun.
- Echinacea purpurea* 'Magnus Superior' Few D \$9.00
To 1 metre. Large daisy-like flowers with magenta- pink petals surrounding an orange/brown central coned in mid-summer. Great for cutting. Attracts butterflies/birds. Adapts to droughts, moist soil, heat or poor soil.
- Echinacea purpurea* 'White Swan' D \$10.00
Stunning flowers. White daisy like flowers summer/autumn. Prominent, coppery/green, central cones surrounded by large white ray-like petals that are 10 cms long. sun. Attracts bees, butterflies.
- Echinops Ritro* – Blue D \$10.00
To 120 cms. Heat tolerant, flowering during summer. Great as cut/dried flowers. Golf ball sized blue flower heads. Sun and well-drained soil.
- Echium pininana* Collect \$7.00 or 5 for \$33
Single-trunked shrubby plant that develop a short stout woody trunk up to 2 metres long, bearing a dense mass of deep green leaves and small pale blue to mauve flowers (pink in bud). To 4 metres in height. Biennial or triennial. Dies after flowering but easily self seeds. Specimen plant.
- Epimediums are great for dry shade as ground covers. 30 – 35 cms.
Foliage often takes on autumn tonings later in the season.
- Epimediums mixed – may include pink/red, creamy lemon, yellow, or autumn tonings \$9.00
- Eranthis hyemalis* Summer dormant \$8.00
Early flowering July to August. Shady woodland ideal, moist humousy soil.
- Eryngium Agavifolium* D \$10.00
To 1 metre. Striking foliage in rosettes of spikey-edged leaves. Burnished green flowers in summer. Part/full shade. Tolerates summer drought. Good for dried flowers and attracting bumblebees.
- Eryngium planum* 'Blue Hobbit' D \$10.00
(Sea Holly). To 30 cms. Open umbels of prickly steel-blue flowers which are good for cutting, fresh or dried. Dwarf strain for sunny border. Attractive to butterflies.
- Erysimum Lemon Mist* \$10.00
To 90 mm in height. Low growing ground cover habit, Lemon yellow flowers over small green leaves flowering commencing in early spring.
- Erysimum Orange Flame* \$9.00
Low growing ground cover with luminous orange/yellow flowers – long flowering. Sun. Suits rockery/edging.
- Erythronium revolutum* 'White Beauty' D \$8.00
(Dog's Tooth Violet). To 30 cms. Elegant pure white flowers and brown basal spots; white and brown veined foliage. Woodland plant, spring flowering.

D = winter dormant

- Farfugium japonicum argenteum* \$24.00
Used to be known as *Ligularia*. Height to 40 cms. Striking foliage plant with large leaves up to 50 cms across when fully mature. Splashes of white on green leaves. Shade is best. Yellow flowers
- Felicia amelloides blue* Few \$10.00
50 cms. Bright blue daisy flowers with yellow centres spring/summer. Sun and good drainage. Drought tolerant.
- Filipendula Double Cream* D \$9.00
(Meadowsweet). Height to 1.5 metres. Numerous double cream flowers in mid-summer. Best with constant moisture in part shade or full sun.
- Filipendula palmata 'Nana'* D \$9.00
To 80 cms. Lovely bright pink flowers in feathery corymbs on simple or branching stems in summer. Sun or shade. Border or woodland garden.
- Francoa sonchifolia* Few \$9.00
(Bridal Wreath). Dark green leaves to 30 cms. Spikes to 70 cms with pale pink flowers with deeper pink veins. Sun/part shade. Good cut flower.
- Francoa mixed* \$9.00
May include white or pink shades.
- Gentiana lutea* D \$10.00
To 1.2 metres. Whorled clusters of yellow flowers in summer. Suits sun/light woodland area. Moist well-drained soil.
- Gentiana makinoi marsha* D \$10.00
To 60 cms. Dark-green leaves and clusters of electric-blue flowers from mid summer to autumn. Moist well-drained soil in sun/part shade
- Gentiana triflora 'Blue Magic'* D \$9.00
To 30 cms. Compact with light blue flowers in summer. Forms a slow spreading carpet. Great for containers or edge or border or rockery. Sun or part shade.
- Gentiana triflora 'White Magic'* D \$9.00
To 30 cms. Compact with white flowers in summer. Forms a slow spreading carpet. Great for containers or edge or border or rockery. Sun or part shade.
- Geranium aristum (Cranesbill)* Few \$9.00
To 60 cms. Soft pink flowers with deep pink veins from late spring. Totally reflexed petals. Shade.
- Geranium 'Katherine Adele'* Few D \$8.00
Suitable for part shade, woodland conditions. Fertile well-drained soil. To 30 cms in flower. Compact with beautiful brown markings on leaves and pretty pink flowers.
- Geranium pratense f. albiflorum* D \$10.00
To 50 cms. Deeply divided leaves, hairy stems with pretty white flowers. Sun/part shade. Clump forming.
- Geranium pyrenaicum 'Bill Wallis'* \$8.00
(Cranesbill). 30 cms. Clump forming with deep purple flowers spring to autumn. Sun/part shade.

Geranium x magnificum (Cranesbill). 50 cms. Deeply cut green foliage. Large, showy cup-shaped violet-blue flowers.	D	\$9.00
Geum coccineum 'Koi' To 20 cms. Dwarf variety with compact bright orange-red flowers late spring to summer. 1 to 1.5 litre		\$8.00
Geum 'Firestorm' To 50 cms. Bright, tangerine orange, double flowers on compact plants. This vigorous, compact and long blooming plant is easy to grow in almost any garden. Easy and carefree.		\$10.00

Gillenia trifoliata To 1 metre. Masses of slender 5-petalled star-like white flowers held in loose corymbs on wiry, branching, distinctively red stems in late spring to early summer. Part shade. Attractive foliage.	Few	D \$10.00
Gypsophila Repens rosea Lovely ground cover with pink flowers from spring onwards. Sun. 1 to 1.5 litre.	D	\$9.00
Helleborus x orientalis Mixed New Leaf growth after flowering. . May include pink, red or purply pink shades. Light shade.		\$10.00
Helianthemum Ben Ledi Evergreen, glossy dark green leaves. Height to 20 cms. Alpine or rock plant. Suitable for over edging. Sun and well-drained soil. Saucer shaped red flowers late spring to summer.		\$9.00
Hepatica nobilis Mixed Lavender blue to blue flowers in spring- some have marbled leaves.	Few	\$9.00
Hosta fortunei 'Gold Standard' (Plaintain Lily). 55 cms. Light green leaves turning gold in summer with dark green edge, lavender flowers. Part shade, moist well drained soil. 1.5 to 2 litre pots.	D	\$12.00
Hosta 'Fire Island' To 40 cms. Brilliant yellow leaves accented by bright red petioles in spring. Leaves become gently rippled with some corrugation at maturity. Best with morning sun and dappled shade later in the day. Lavender flowers in summer. Red stems.	D	\$10.00
Hosta 'Fragrant Blue' To 50 cms. Chalky blue leaves with some corrugation. Holds blue colour well into the season. Light lavender flowers summer.	D	\$10.00

- Hosta 'Hudson Bay' D \$10.00
To 60 cms. Creamy white centres surrounded by a wide irregular blue/green margin. There is a light green colour that streaks in between the centre colour and margin. Near white flowers. 1 litre.
- Hosta 'Kiwiskyscraper' D \$12.00
To 1 metre. Rich blue-green, thick foliage in a distinctly upright large mound. Great background or specimen plant. Moist, rich soil and part to full shade. 1.5 to 2 litre
- Hosta Loyalist D \$10.00
Pure white centres and very dark green margins. The leaves are heavy with substance. Lavender flowers are produced on white flower stems. 1 litre.
- Hosta 'Sagae' D \$12.00
90cms. Frosty blue green leaves with creamy white margins. Part to full shade. One of the best Hostas with very good form.
- Hosta Sieboldiana Glauca D \$12.00
To 90 cms. Lovely blue-green heavily ribbed leaves. Droopy mauve bell-shaped flowers late summer. Shade, moist humus rich soil. 1.5 to 2 litre pots.
- Iberis sempervirens Few \$9.00
(Evergreen Candytuft). To 30 cms. Lovely ground cover for over rocks, walls, edging. Glossy, evergreen foliage and many large white flowers. Sun/part shade, good drainage. Sub-shrub.
- Japanese Irises for sun, moist soil and ideal for pond edging. Best collected mid spring.
- Iris Higo 'World's Delight' - 1 metre. Huge pale pink flattened flowers. D \$8.00
- Iris 'Raspberry Acres' \$8.00
Bearded Intermediate – To 70 cms. Standards and falls are white with a maroon tinge, with deep maroon around the slightly frilly edges. Quite a big flower.
- Jasione montana f. alba 'White Delight' \$10.00
To 15 cms. Low growing and clump forming. 7 lobed deeply divided green leaves forming mounds. In summer dense cluster of white saucer shaped flowers on slender stems.
- Knautia macedonica 'Mars Midget' \$10.00
To 40 cms. Low mound of grey green leaves. Small ruby-red button flowers over several months. Sunny border, containers or rock garden. Attracts butterflies. May be short-lived but self-seeds.
- Lathyrus latifolius 'White Pearl' D \$9.00
Large white flowers in summer. Climber. Sun.
- Lathyrus latifolius 'Red Pearl' D \$9.00
Rare perennial sweet pea. Heavy trusses of bright carmine red, fleshy, substantial flowers on long strong stems in summer. Climber. Sun or partial shade. Fertile humus rich, well drained soil.
- Lathyrus latifolius 'Pink Pearl' D \$9.00
Lovely pale pink flowers in summer. Sun/part shade. Climber. Best on fence or trellis as it naturally twines. Fertile humus rich, well drained soil. Fully hardy.

- Ligularia reniformis* Few \$9.00
(Tractor seat *Ligularia*). Mature size - 100 x 100 cms. Bog plant. Huge kidney-shaped, glossy green leaves. Foliage is tractor seat like. Good landscape plant. Yellow flowered daisies mid-summer.. Moist, well drained soil in semi shade. 1 litre pots.
- Lychnis viscaria* 'Splendens Plena' (Sticky Plant) D \$8.00
To 50 cms. Stunning with spikes of double pink flowers spring/summer.
- Lysimachia congestiflora* D \$9.00.
To 15 cms. Mat forming ground cover. Showy cup-shaped, 5-petaled, yellow flowers from late spring-summer. Part or full shade, moist soil. Suitable for edging, rock garden, waterside garden.
- Lysimachia punctata* Trimmed for courier D \$8.00
To 90 cms. Loose spikes of starry yellow flowers in summer. Ground cover for sun or partial shade. Attractive to butterflies and good for cutting. 1 litre.
- Maimanthemum racemosum* Few D \$8.00
(*Smilacina racemosa*). To 90 cms. Veined mid green leaves and plumes of feathery creamy white flowers from spring to mid-summer, followed by red berries. Part shade. Suits a woodland garden.
- Nierembergia repens* D \$8.00
(Cup Flower). Cup-shaped white blooms over green foliage. Great ground cover around stepping-stones, between rocks, or in alpine gardens. Light shade to sun and moist to wet soil. Plants grown in more sun will have more blooms but also require more moisture.
- Omphalodes Kuzinskyana* \$8.00
Evergreen. To 30 cms. Blue, forget me not like flowers from spring onwards. Good ground cover for semi shade. Long flowering. Lightly self seeds.
- Omphalodes verna* 'Alba' D \$9.00
20 to 30 cms. Dark green, grooved leaves. Useful ground cover for under trees/shrubs. Sprays of white flowers. Light shade, average moisture.
- Ophiopogon Planiscarpus* 'Black Dragon' \$9.00
(Black Mondo Grass). Popular landscaping plant with deep purple-black grass like leaves, punctuated by dainty flowers of pale violet followed by shiny black berries. Great contrast plant for mass planting in sun or shade. Prefers well-drained soil. 1 litre pots.
- Paeonia Deep Pink* – double D \$25.00
1 to 1.2 metres in height. Deep pink, fully double flowers. 4 eyes or buds.
- Oriental Poppies have large cup-shaped flowers from late spring. Sunny, well-drained position.
Ground cover. May have light second flowering. 60 to 80 cms.
- Papaver orientale* 'Doubloon' -glowing, orange semi-double flowers with black centre. D\$9.00
- Papaver orientale* 'Empress of India' D \$9.00
Huge dark red black blotched flowers.
- Papaver orientale* 'Prince Charming' D \$9.00
60 cms. Large orange and white flowers with orange edge and black tasselled centre.

To 80 cms. Really large, salmon pink flowers late spring/early summer-very stunning. Clump forming, hardy perennial. Flowers twice in a season. Sun. Easy to grow.		
Peltiphyllum Peltata (Darmera peltata)	D	\$9.00
To 1.3 metres. Rounded cymes of numerous 5-petalled pink flowers to 1.5 cms across in late spring followed by large, rounded leaves. Rounded, deeply lobed, coarsely toothed, dark green leaves, with conspicuous veins to 60 cms across, that turn red in autumn. Part or full shade. 1 litre.		
Persicaria microcephala 'Red Dragon'	Collect or needs trimmed	D \$8.00
To 90 cms. Beautiful foliage. Pointy heart-shaped leaves are medium green with a silvery V-shaped marking and a bronze centre. Sprays of tiny white flowers late summer. Part or full shade. Large.		
Phlox paniculata 'Le Madhi' (Trimmed)	D	\$9.00
90 cms Large fragrant heads of purple flowers in summer. Sun/part shade. Clump forming ground cover.		
Phlox subulata 'White Delight'		\$9.00
To 15 cms. Low growing, mat-forming ground cover. Large pure white flowers late spring. Suits rocky areas, on slopes and in flower borders. Sun.		
Pinellia tripartita	D	\$9.00
To 30 cms. Moist well-drained soil part/full shade. Yellowish-green flower late spring/summer.		
Podophyllum emodi	D	\$9.00
